

It is understood that groups or organizations from the various schools may have the need to raise funds from time to time. The following will provide guidelines for any fundraising activities.

1. Fund raising activities should be in the form of service projects, i.e., car washes, cleaning yards, painting, picking up litter, etc. Students will not be asked to sell door to door tickets or items for "Games of Chance".
2. All fundraisers must be approved by the building principal.
3. The selling of items, or solicitation of funds by students in any way on a door to door basis must be approved by the board of education. Door to door will be defined as asking students in any way to take items home to be sold to family, neighbors, or going up and down streets or roads and selling items. Those ongoing board approved activities include the following:
