

WIRELESS INTERNET ACCESS

The Grace School District #148 Board of Trustees supports wireless internet access as a means of providing additional opportunities for research, collaboration, and communication that is directly related to school assignments and projects. The Superintendent/designee is directed to develop and implement procedures that, to the extent possible, protect students from access to inappropriate materials over the wireless connection and that support the acquisition of skills to analyze and evaluate resources.

Guidelines

Technical Support

The District Technology Department will not provide technical support for hardware or software on personal wireless devices.

Limitation of Liability

1. Grace School District #148 makes no guarantee that the functions or the services provided by the wireless network system will be without defect.
2. The District will not be responsible for any damages suffered, including but not limited to:
 - a. loss of data,
 - b. interruptions of service,
 - c. accuracy or quality of information obtained through or stored on the system, or
 - d. any financial obligations arising through the unauthorized use of the system.

Violations

1. Violation of the provisions of this policy shall result in disciplinary action, including but not limited to:
 - a. confiscation of the device by an administrator or staff member,
 - b. loss of the privilege of bringing the device onto school property,
 - c. required restitution for any damage to the network caused by hacking,
 - d. detention,
 - e. suspension,
 - f. expulsion, or

g. termination from employment.

2. Where appropriate, law enforcement authorities may be contacted.

DEFINITION

Wireless Devices any piece of equipment that is able to connect to the internet through the District's wireless network (cell phones, laptops, I-phones, I-pads, PDAs, etc.).

WIRELESS INTERNET USE AGREEMENT FORM

I understand and will abide by the Terms and Conditions for access to the District's wireless network. I realize this is a privilege and a responsibility. By signing this agreement, I commit to:

- Only use the District's wireless network for educational purposes;
- Select appropriate, tasteful screensavers and wallpaper;
- Personal ownership of software residing on my wireless device;
- Ensure that current virus protection software is loaded on my device along with the latest security patches for the device's operating system;
- Ensure that the device is free of spyware, adware, worms, viruses, Trojan horses, or peer to peer software;
- Behave ethically and responsibly;
- Being responsible for the way my wireless device is used regardless of whether I or a borrower is using the device;
- Using the District provided wireless connection that is filtered according to the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA) requirements;
- Setting up my own personal wireless device for use on the District's wireless network;
- Ensuring that my wireless device will work properly on the District's wireless network;
- Providing any necessary cables, network cards, etc.;
- Maintaining my wireless device and making sure it is charged prior to bring it to school;
- Securing my personal wireless device when it is not in use or in my possession;
- Taking my personal wireless device home daily;
- Not lending or borrowing usernames, passwords, or account access;
- Not using non-District wireless service providers while on District property;
- Not plugging my personal wireless device into the District's wired network;
- Not opening, viewing, modifying, or deleting files belonging to another user without his/her permission;
- Not electronically posting personal information;
- Not downloading copyrighted information without the permission of the copyright holder or plagiarizing;
- Not engaging in any illegal activity;
- Not intentionally introducing a virus or other malicious programs onto the District's system;
- Not posting messages or accessing materials that are abusive, obscene, sexually oriented, threatening, harassing, damaging to another's reputation, or illegal;
- Not disabling, bypassing, or attempting to disable or bypass any system monitoring, filtering, or other security measures;
- Not using peer to peer file sharing, a hosting service, or having an internet connection sharing service running on my wireless device.
