For grades one (1) and two (2), students' progress and achievement will be reported on a scale of one to five (1-5) in the separate areas of development with the numbers giving the following value:

- 1. Making very good progress;
- 2. Making satisfactory progress;
- *3. Showing improvement;*
- 4. Needs improvement; or
- 5. Working to capacity, but not on grade level.

For grades three through twelve (3-12), students' progress and achievement will be reported on the basis of the letter grades A, B, C, D, and F.

The letter grades interpreted will have the following numerical values:

A = 90-100B = 80-89

C = 70-79

D = 60-69

F = Below 60

Grades granted in partial credit courses will not be computed on the secondary level for purposes of determining membership in honor groups or organizations, or class rank.
