

For grades one (1) and two (2), students' progress and achievement will be reported on a scale of one to five (1-5) in the separate areas of development with the numbers giving the following value:

1. *Making very good progress;*
2. *Making satisfactory progress;*
3. *Showing improvement;*
4. *Needs improvement; or*
5. *Working to capacity, but not on grade level.*

For grades three through twelve (3-12), students' progress and achievement will be reported on the basis of the letter grades A, B, C, D, and F.

The letter grades interpreted will have the following numerical values:

- A = 90-100*
- B = 80-89*
- C = 70-79*
- D = 60-69*
- F = Below 60*

Grades granted in partial credit courses will not be computed on the secondary level for purposes of determining membership in honor groups or organizations, or class rank.
