

School transportation may be used in connection with the operation and support of extracurricular and student activities upon approval of the superintendent or designee.

Students riding to an activity in a school bus are expected to return on it. (The principal or designee can make an exception.) Students on such trips are required to comply with the rules and regulations governing daily school transportation.

The Grace School District buses will be made available for public use under the following conditions:

- 1. A rental fee equal to the districts state designated cost will be charged groups within the district for the use of a trip or yellow bus. No groups from outside the district will be allowed to use the trip bus.*
- 2. The destination must be within a 300 mile radius of Grace, Idaho.*
- 3. For rental usage, the bus driver will be compensated for meals at \$7.00, \$8.00 and \$12.00, plus lodging costs*
- 4. The use of the bus must not interfere in any way with school or district use. All district activities come first in priority.*
- 5. A bus authorization request must be filled out and submitted to the Superintendent for approval. Approval must be granted before bus is used.*
- 6. Any request to use the bus by community or "outside groups" beyond a 300 mile radius must be approved by the school board.*
- 7. Use of "charter" or professional carriers should first be checked out before requests are made of the school district.*
- 8. Under no circumstances is the use of the Grace activity buses to be a commercial venture in competition with professional carriers... We are not in the "charter bus" business.*
- 9. Any damage to the bus will be the responsibility of the user group to repair or pay for repair.*
