

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Due to new federal regulations, charging for school lunch will no longer be an option in the Grace School District. The change will go into effect on October 6, 2014. All lunch balances will need to be paid in full by this date.

Parents will be notified by text message or email when lunch balances drop below \$6.00. It will be the responsibility of parents to make sure the school has your contact information. (Cell phone # and email address.) When the balance reaches zero, students no longer be served a school lunch. Students at the elementary schools will be served a partial lunch for up to three (3) days only.

Payments for school lunches can be made through the following methods:

- (1) Secretaries in school offices or directly to Kelli Aplanalp in the high school cafeteria;
- (2) online through the school website (www.sd148.org) via Instapayment. (Your child's id# is required, which is available through building secretaries or Kelli Aplanalp, School Lunch Supervisor.)

Free/Reduced lunch applications will be accepted any time during the school year. You may get a copy of the application on the school website. A new form needs to be completed each school year. Completed applications may be submitted to Kelli Aplanalp. Lunch prices for the 2016/17 school year are \$2.30 at the elementary schools and \$2.40 at the high school.
